### Here's what you should do!

- Place **ALL recyclables** (see reverse side) **INSIDE** of the **commingled green recycling cart** and place all other trash in your brown tipper cart. Only items in the recycling cart will be picked up – no items left outside of the cart.
- If the material is NOT listed as acceptable on the reverse side of this recycling guide, discard the material with your normal household refuse.
- Recycling carts mixed with household refuse or garbage carts mixed with recycling will NOT be picked up.

## STREET DEPARTMENT

### SELF DEPOSIT STATION HOURS

#### Winter Hours

December 1st through March 31st  
 Tuesday AND Friday 11:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.  
 Saturday 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

#### Summer Hours

April 1st through November 30th  
 Tuesday AND Friday 11:30 a.m. – 6:30 p.m.  
 Saturday 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

**Hours are subject to change. Please check the City's website for the current Self Deposit Station hours or call the Street Department at 768-8075.**

### SELF DEPOSIT STATION REGULATIONS

1. South Milwaukee Residents only – ID required  
No Contractors or contractor material.
2. No Dump trucks allowed.
3. Instructions of the attendant must be followed at all times.
4. A 5-minute maximum unloading time.
5. Lumber and boards not to exceed 5 feet in length
6. Used motor oil and anti-freeze only
7. No paints or hazardous chemicals
8. Charges are as follows:

User Fee (each day)	\$ 2.00
Tires exceeding 17" rim size (off rim only)	\$ 7.00 each
Tires less than 17" rim size (off rim only)	\$ 3.00 each
Grass bagged or 32 gallon container	\$ 1.00 each
Televisions and computer monitors with a CRT tube	\$10.00 each



### YARD WASTE

The City provides for drop off of yard waste at the Self Deposit Station. Residents may bring leaves, yard debris, garden debris, plants, shrubs and thatch to the Self Deposit Station for disposable with no charge other than the daily user fee. Green grass clippings are accepted for an additional fee of \$1.00 per bag or 32 gallon container. Any yard waste that has green grass clippings in it is chargeable at the above rate. No yard waste is collected at the property.

### BRUSH

Branches and bushes that can go through the chipper can be collected by Special Pick Up. Call the Street Department to make arrangements.

### LEAVES

Leaves can be placed in the curb beginning **October 1 through November 15**. No other yard waste, branches or plants can be placed in the curb. Due to changes at the landfill sites and the added costs involved, we ask you to consider mulching your leaves. It will save you the time it takes to rake and your back when you mulch the leaves with your lawn mower. The added advantage is that the leaves break down and feed your lawn so come spring your grass will be nice and green.

## STREET DEPARTMENT

### GARBAGE COLLECTION

Garbage must be brought out by 7 a.m. on the day of collection. **During winter months, garbage or other refuse shall not be placed on snow banks or on sidewalks behind snow banks but shall be placed in a cleared driveway or a cleared section of the deposit area if there is not a driveway.** Tipper carts must always be in an unobstructed area and require a minimum tipping area of four (4) feet. ### CHRISTMAS TREE AND WREATH DISPOSAL

Christmas trees should be placed at the curb for collection. Please remove all lights and decorations. Wreaths will be collected with the garbage.

### SNOW REMOVAL

It is the responsibility of each property owner to remove the snow and ice from the sidewalk in front of or adjacent to their property within 24 hours of daylight after the snow or ice has fallen. Snow should be removed to the full width of the sidewalk. **Throwing snow into the roadway is prohibited.** The garbage pickup area should be cleared of snow before your garbage collection day. Snow shall not be shoveled, blown or plowed into or across the street or alley right-of-way.

### ELECTRONICS

Electronics such as televisions, computers, printers, monitors, DVD's, VCR's etc. can be taken to the Self Deposit Station. There is a \$10.00 fee for televisions and computer monitors with a CRT tube.

### SPECIAL PICK UP

The Street Department provides Special Pick Up of waste material not normally collected with your regular garbage. Generally this is for large household items and/or branches and brush that can go through the chipper (No yard waste). See the City website or call for more information.

### STREET LIGHT OUTAGES

### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Milwaukee County residents can bring household hazardous waste to these year round drop-off points.

# GUIDE TO RECYCLING

## PAPER PRODUCTS

Corrugated boxes should be flattened and cut to a size that will not get stuck in cart.

### ACCEPTABLE

- Newspapers & inserts
- Magazines & books
- Junk mail & envelopes
- Phone books & Catalogs
- Office paper (any color)
- Corrugated cardboard
- Paper grocery bags
- Non-corrugated cardboard (cereal boxes, soda pack boxes)



### NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Tissue products and paper towels
- Frozen food boxes
- Dairy carton boxes
- Paper contaminated with food residue or other debris
- Pizza boxes or carry out food wrappers

## GLASS – Clear, green, brown, and tinted glass

Please rinse and remove lids and caps.

### ACCEPTABLE

- Any color glass bottles, jugs or jars
- Glass beverage & glass food containers



### NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Ceramic items (dishes, vases, cups)
- Drinking glasses or crystal
- Light bulbs
- Window or auto glass

## PLASTIC – Containers labeled 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7

on the bottom. Please rinse and remove lids and caps. Not necessary to remove paper labels.

### ACCEPTABLE

- Soda bottles
- Milk & water jugs
- Laundry bottles
- Shampoo, conditioner, lotion & cosmetic bottles



### NOT ACCEPTABLE

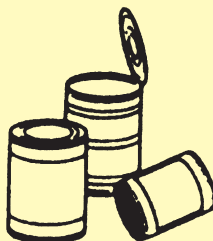
- Motor oil & Antifreeze bottles
- Styrofoam or microwave containers
- Plastic toys, flower pots/garden plastics
- Pesticide or herbicide containers
- Dairy tubs (butter, margarine, yogurt, sour cream)
- Medical supplies
- Plastic bags

## CANS – Please rinse all cans

Not necessary to remove paper labels.

### ACCEPTABLE

- All aluminum cans
- All steel or bi-metal cans
- Metal lids & bottle caps



### NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Aluminum foil & pie tins
- Paint cans & aerosol cans
- Car parts, nails & screws
- Pots & pans
- Gasoline cans & scrap metal
